
## MONTHLY STATISTICS DEC 2019

### People Arrived on Aegean islands




In 2019, people arriving is up 86.9%, compared to 2018. In December 178 boats made it to the Greek islands, carrying a total of 6223 people. Arrivals has decreased 27.2% compared to November, boats arriving is down 25.8%. Demographics on the islands: Men 43%, Women 22% and Children 35%

### Boats arrived on the islands




### Boats stopped by TCG/Police



Total arrivals are up by 119% compared to same period in 2018. 358 boats started their trip towards the Greek islands in December, carrying a total of 12841 people. 178 boats made the trip, carrying a total of 6223 people, the rest, 180 boats, 16618 people, were arrested by the Turkish Coast guard and Police.

### Total numbers so far this year



In 2019 3140 boats have been stopped on their way towards Greece, 107981 people have been arrested. Both boats arriving on the Greek island, and boats stopped by TCG/Police is extremely high compared to previous years, population on the islands is almost at 42000.




## MONTHLY STATISTICS NOV 2019

### Arrivals and transfers by island

In December 4194 people were transported to mainland, from the Greek islands. Transfers have decreased 29.7% compared to November, when 5964 people were transported. In 2019 population on the Aegean islands has increased by 186.7%, from 14615 to 41899 people. Greek government's efforts to reduce population on the islands has failed massively.



### Population on each island



Official capacity on the islands is 9209 people. Today's population exceeds this by 355%. In the end of November total population was 39026, one month later its 41899, population has increased by 2873 people this last month on the Greek Islands.
