

People Arrived on Aegean islands




In 2020, people arriving is down 82.7%, compared to 2019. In November 16 boats made it to the Greek islands, carrying a total of 364 people. Arrivals has increased 338.5% compared to October, boats arriving is up 300%. Demographics on the islands: Men 51%, Women 21% and Children 28%

Boats arrived on the islands




Boats stopped by TCG/Police



Total arrivals are down by 95.7% compared to same month in 2019. 63 boats started their trip towards the Greek islands in November, carrying a total of 1571 people. 16 boats made the trip, carrying a total of 364 people, the rest, 47 boats, 1207 people, were picked up by the Turkish Coast guard, most of these boats had been pushed back by Greek Coast Guard.

Total numbers so far this year



In 2020 736 boats have been stopped on their way towards Greece, 23930 people have been arrested. Boats arriving on the Greek island has been reduced due to the Greek governments pushback tactics, boats picked up by TCG has increased for the same reason. Also the COVID-19 pandemic have had a huge impact. Population on the islands is 17424.





Arrivals and transfers by island

In November 909 people were transported to mainland, from the Greek islands. Transfers have decreased 70.8% compared to October, when 3116 people were transported. In the last 12 months population on the Aegean islands has decreased by 55.35%, from 39026 to 17424 people. Greek government's efforts to reduce population on the islands seems to have effect, but illegal pushbacks seems to be the main reason for this suckses.



Population on each island



Official capacity on the islands is 9209 people. Today's population exceeds this by 89.2%. Despite low arrival numbers, population on the Greek islands remains high. Transfer to mainland is slowing down, and it seems like they are satisfied with the current numbers on the island, living conditions in the camps remains inhuman.
