
## MONTHLY STATISTICS DECEMBER 2020

### People Arrived on Aegean islands




In 2020, people arriving is down 84.1%, compared to 2019. In December 13 boats made it to the Greek islands, carrying a total of 205 people. Arrivals has decreased 43.7% compared to November, boats arriving is down 18.8%. Demographics on the islands: Men 51%, Women 21% and Children 28%

### Boats stopped by TCG/Police



Total arrivals are down by 96.7% compared to same month in 2019. 55 boats started their trip towards the Greek islands in December, carrying a total of 1433 people. 13 boats made the trip, carrying a total of 205 people, the rest, 42 boats, 1228 people, were picked up by the Turkish Coast guard, most of these boats had been pushed back by Greek Coast Guard.

### Total numbers so far this year



In 2020 778 boats have been stopped on their way towards Greece, 25158 people have been arrested. Boats arriving on the Greek island has been reduced due to the Greek governments pushback tactics, boats picked up by TCG has increased for the same reason. Also the COVID-19 pandemic have had a huge impact. Population on the islands is 17005..






### Arrivals and transfers by island

In December 492 people were transported to mainland, from the Greek islands. Transfers have decreased 45.9% compared to November, when 909 people were transported. In the last 12 months population on the Aegean islands has decreased by 59.4%, from 41899 to 17005 people. The Greek government have drastically reduced the population on the Greek island in 2020, population is now the same as in July 2019, when New Democracy won the election in Greece.



#### Arrivals




#### Transfers

### Population on each island



Official capacity on the islands is 17184 people. Today's population is almost on max capacity. In the end of 2019 total population was 41899, one year later its 17005, population has decreased by 24894 people this last year on the Greek Islands, living conditions in the camps remains inhuman.
