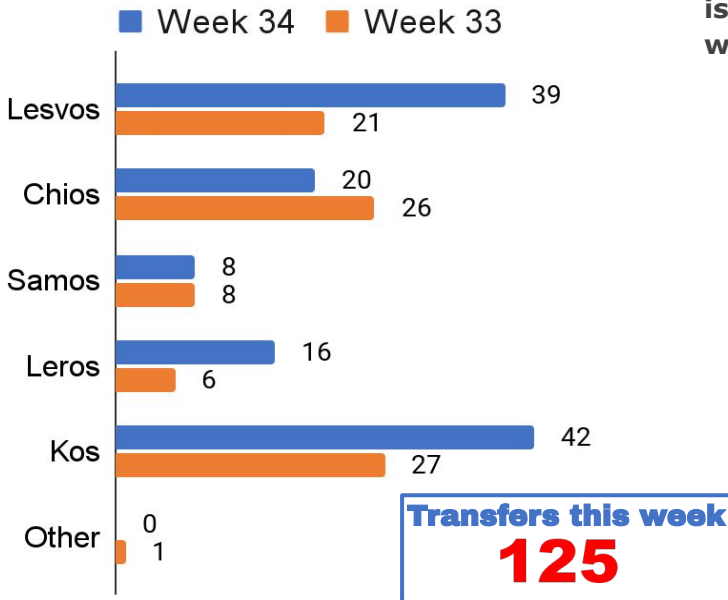

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**52** BOATS  
**1561** PEOPLE

A total of 62 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1956 people. 52 boats were stopped/pushback, and 395 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1003 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 33159 people. 4931 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 218 boat, so far in 2022. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland

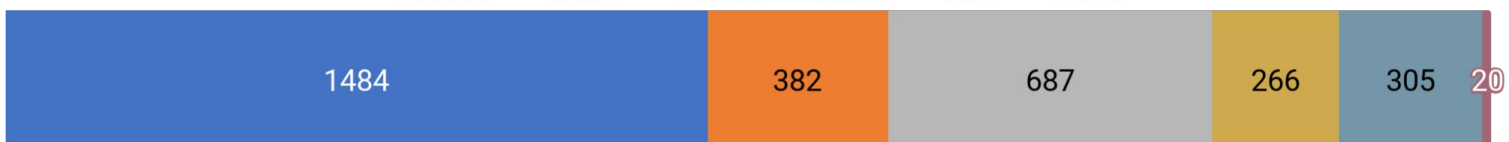


Transfers to mainland have increased 40.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 3144 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 454 people. Demographics on the islands: Men 52%, Women 24%, Children 24% (40% younger than 10 years)

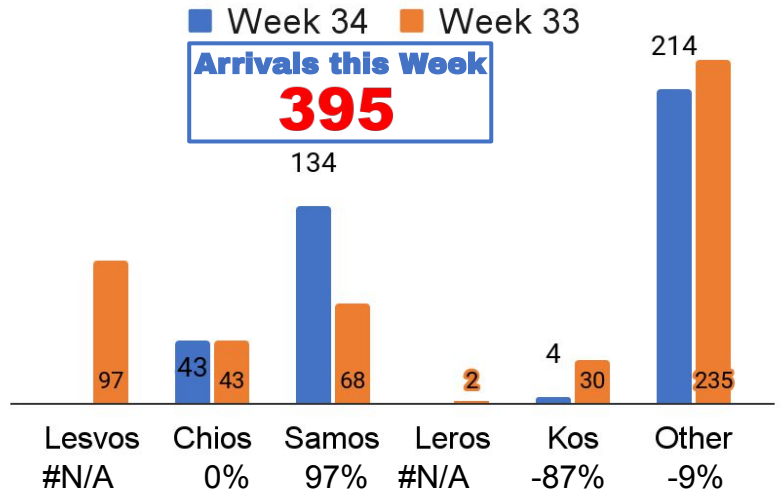
### Population on the Aegean islands

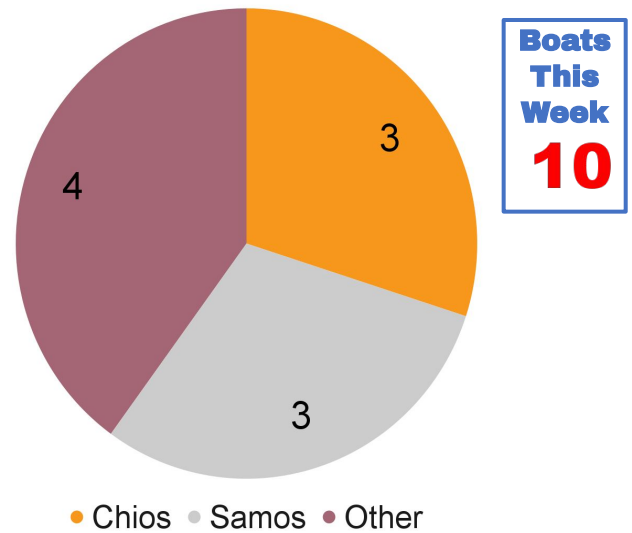


### People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 16.8% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 16 boats last week to 10 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 70 boats last week to 62 boats this week.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 52 boats, 83.9%, 10 boats, 16.1%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 218 boat have arrived on the Islands, 82.2% have been picked up by TCG
