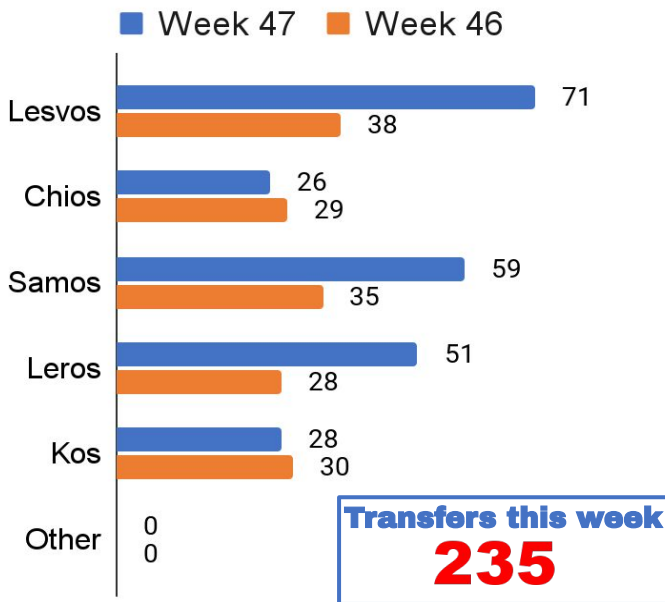

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**18** BOATS  
**437** PEOPLE

A total of 29 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 791 people. 18 boats were stopped/pushback, and 354 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.523 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 47.982 people. 9.292 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 391 boat, so far in 2022. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 46.9% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 4.289 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 505 people. Demographics on the islands: Men 52%, Women 24%, Children 24% (40% younger than 10 years)

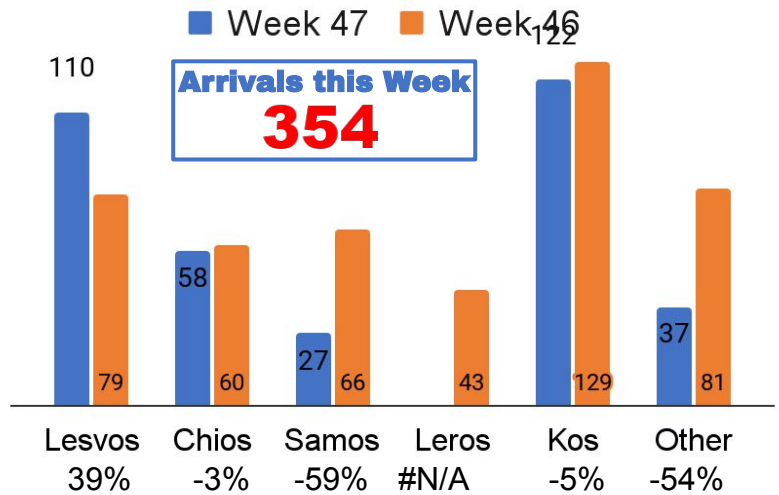

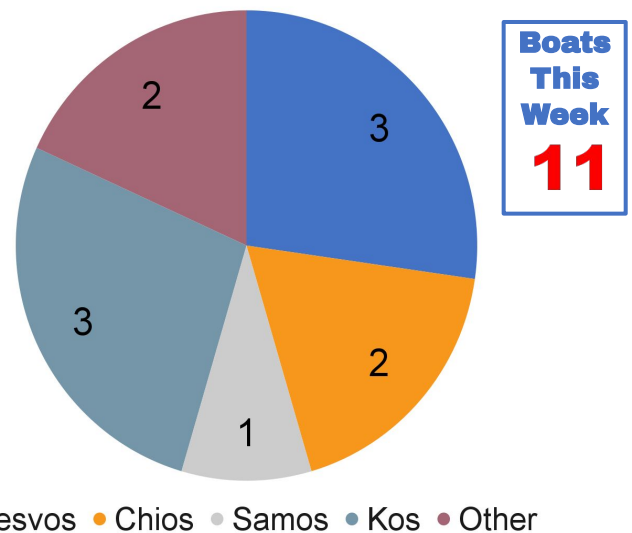


### People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 22.7% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 16 boats last week to 11 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 45 boats last week to 29 boats this week.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 18 boats, 62.1%, 11 boats, 37.9%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 391 boat have arrived on the Islands, 79.6% have been picked up by TCG
