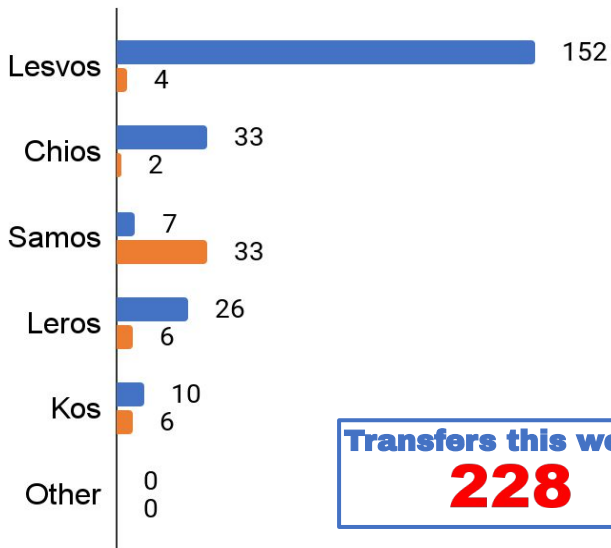
### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**26** BOATS  
**602** PEOPLE

A total of 39 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 901 people. 26 boats were stopped/pushback, and 299 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 63 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 1.822 people. 750 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 29 boat, so far in 2022. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

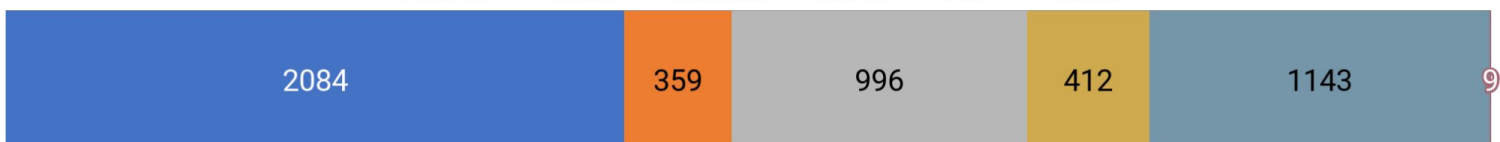

### Population on the Aegean islands

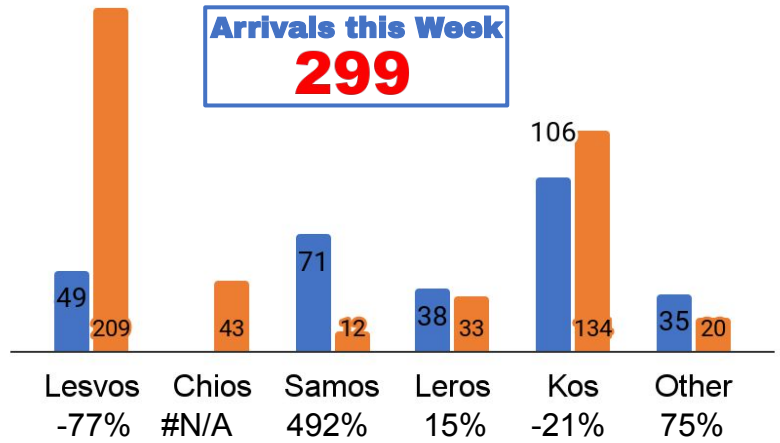

### People Arrived on Aegean islands

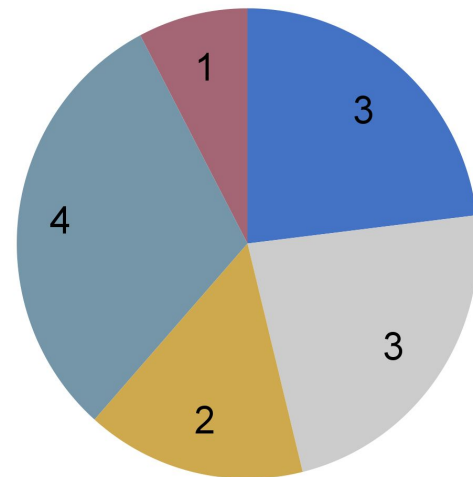

Arrivals have increased 19.3% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 14 boats last week to 16 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 46 boats last week to 48 boats this week.
