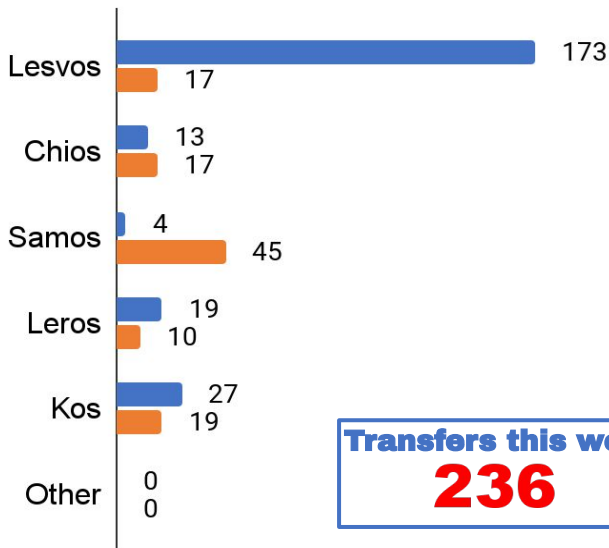
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

27 BOATS
635 PEOPLE

A total of 38 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 944 people. 27 boats were stopped/pushback, and 309 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 103 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 2.776 people. 1.291 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 49 boat, so far in 2022. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

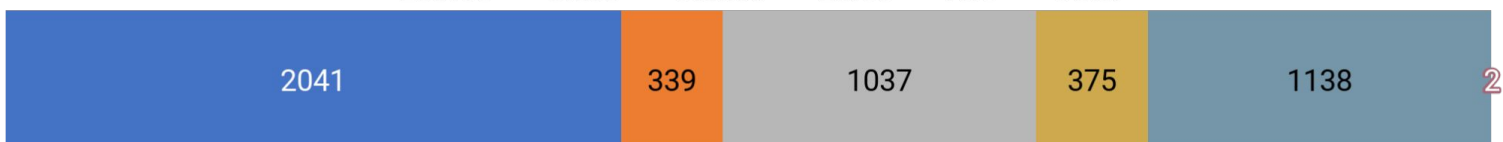

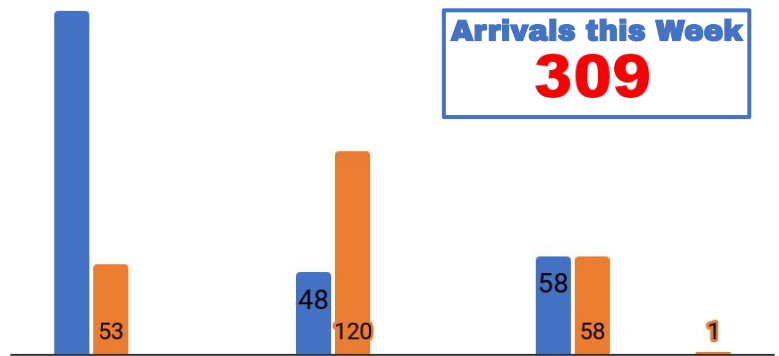
Population on the Aegean islands

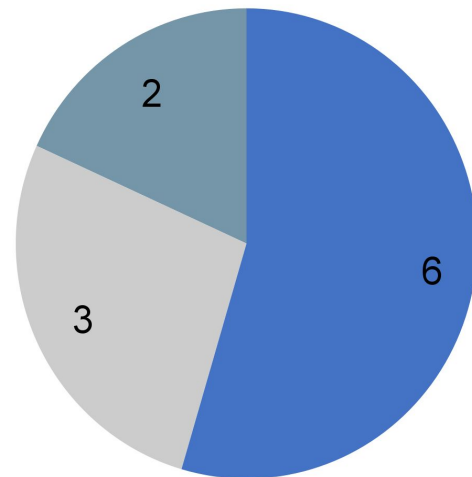
