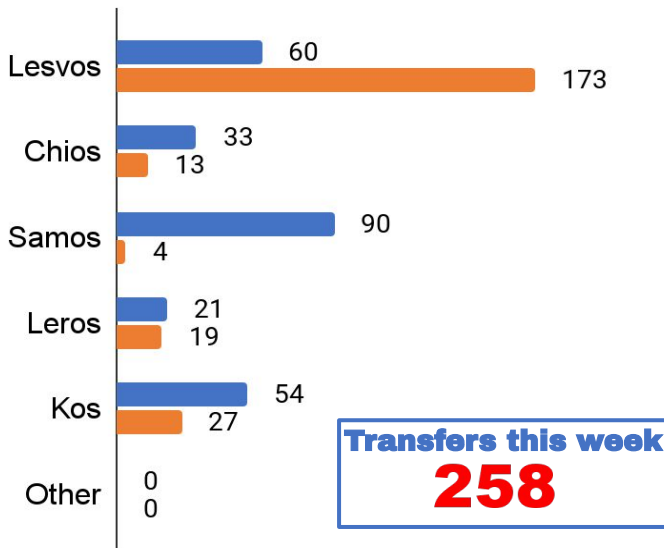
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

18 BOATS
580 PEOPLE

A total of 27 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 821 people. 18 boats were stopped/pushback, and 241 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 121 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 3.356 people. 1.532 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 58 boat, so far in 2022. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Population on the Aegean islands

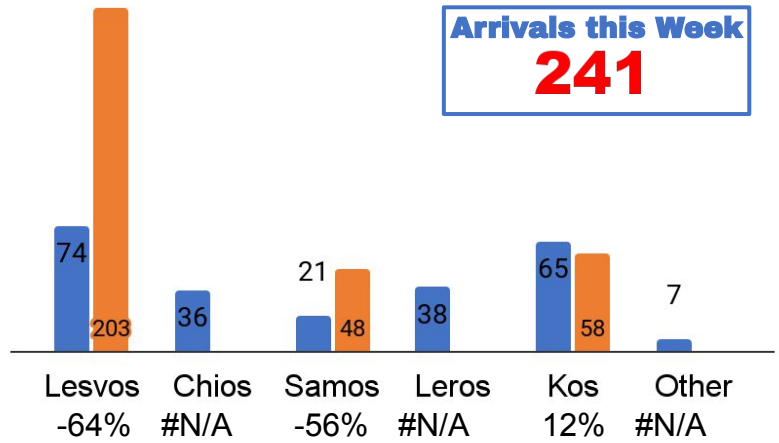

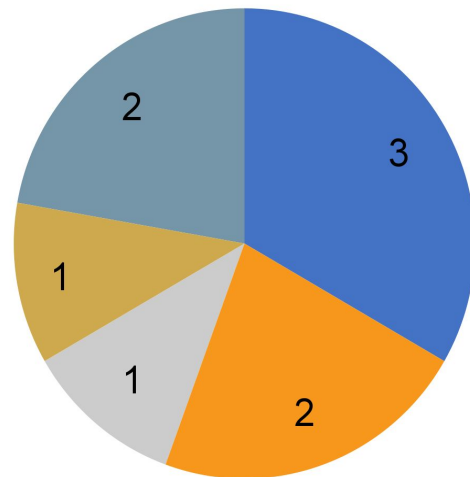
Arrivals this Week
