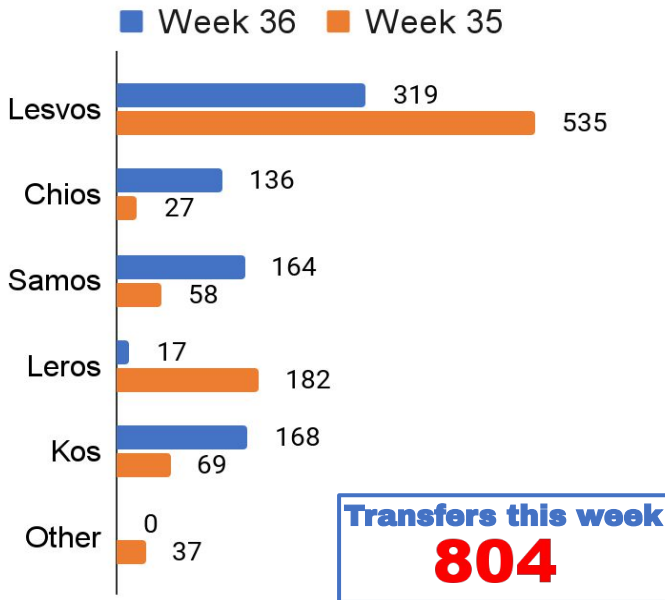

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

46 BOATS
1324 PEOPLE

A total of 149 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 4.215 people. 46 boats were stopped/pushback, and 2.891 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.013 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 27.936 people. 17.089 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 681 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

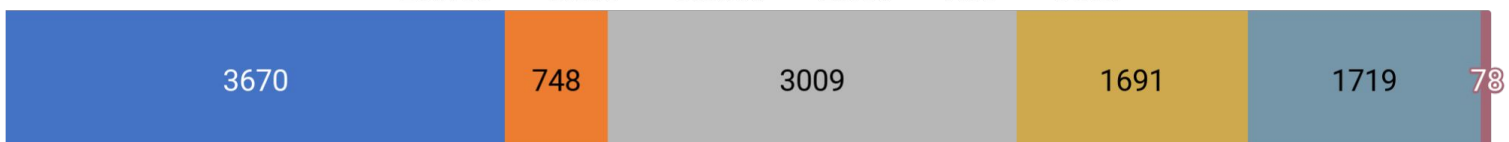
Transfers to Mainland



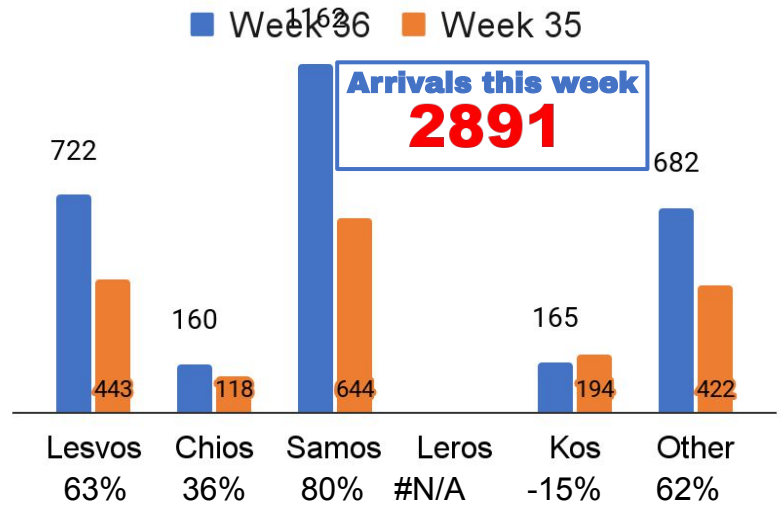
Transfers to mainland have decreased 11.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 10.915 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 5116 people. This is the highest number of people registered on the islands since May 2021, numbers are rapidly increasing due to high arrivals and low transfers to mainland.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

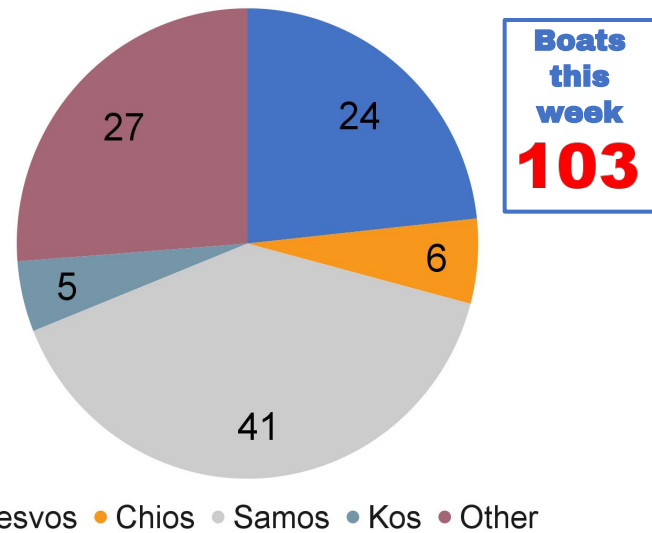


People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 58.8% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 66 boats last week to 103 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 113 boats last week to 149 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 46 boats, 30.9%, 103 boats, 69.1%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 681 boat have arrived on the Islands, 59.8% have been picked up by TCG.
