

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

85 BOATS
2718 PEOPLE

A total of 144 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 4.292 people. 85 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.574 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.376 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 39.894 people. 25.757 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.011 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have increased 13.8% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.534 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 5.082 people. This is the highest number of people registered on the islands since February 2021, numbers are rapidly increasing due to high arrivals and low transfers to mainland.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 20.8% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 79 boats last week to 59 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 196 boats last week to 144 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 85 boats, 59%, 59 boats, 41%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.011 boat have arrived on the Islands, 57.7% have been picked up by TCG.
