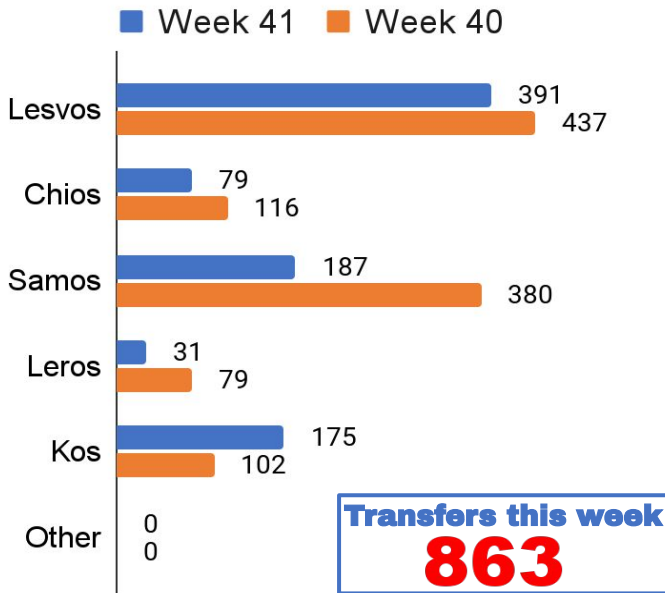

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

103 BOATS
3491 PEOPLE

A total of 153 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 4.844 people. 103 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.353 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.480 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 43.420 people. 27.110 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.061 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

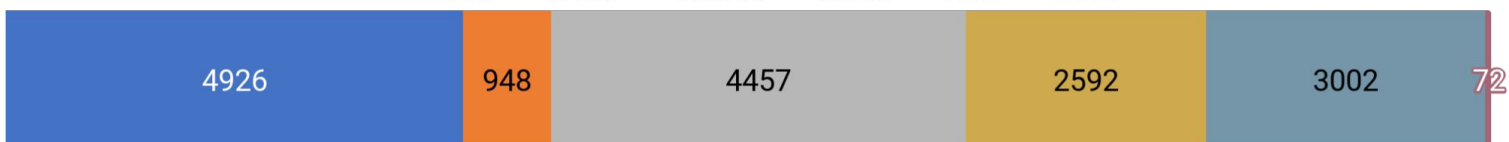
Transfers to Mainland



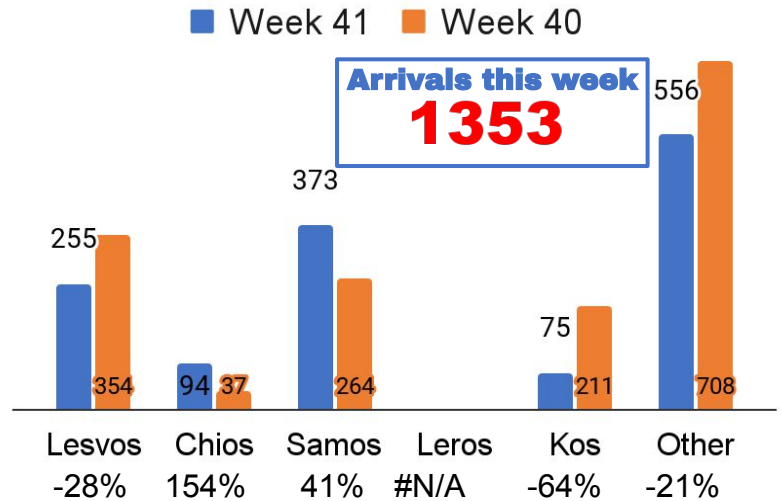
Transfers to mainland have decreased 22.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.997 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 3.263 people. This is the highest number of people registered on the islands since February 2021, numbers are rapidly increasing due to high arrivals and low transfers to mainland.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

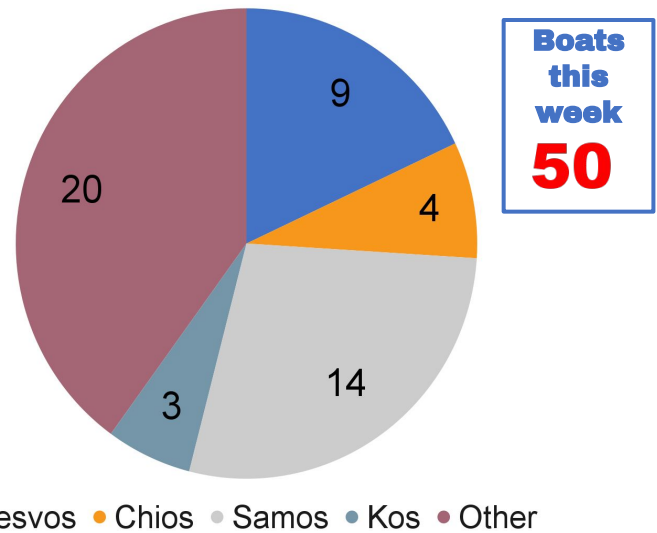


People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 14% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 59 boats last week to 50 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 144 boats last week to 153 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 103 boats, 67.3%, 50 boats, 32.7%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.061 boat have arrived on the Islands, 58.2% have been picked up by TCG.
