

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

71 BOATS
2158 PEOPLE

A total of 127 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 3.657 people. 71 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.499 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.551 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 45.578 people. 28.609 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.117 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.


Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have increased 64.3% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 16.243 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 2.651 people. This is the highest number of people registered on the islands since February 2021, numbers are rapidly increasing due to high arrivals and low transfers to mainland.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 10.8% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 50 boats last week to 56 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 153 boats last week to 127 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 71 boats, 55.9%, 56 boats, 44.1%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.117 boat have arrived on the Islands, 58.3% have been picked up by TCG.
