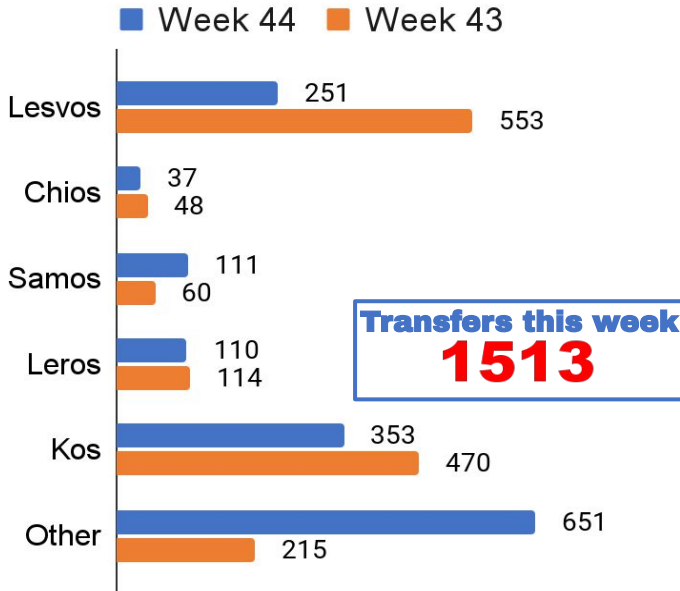

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

62 BOATS
1845 PEOPLE

A total of 88 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 2.711 people. 62 boats were stopped/pushback, and 866 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.691 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 49.538 people. 30.703 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.190 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

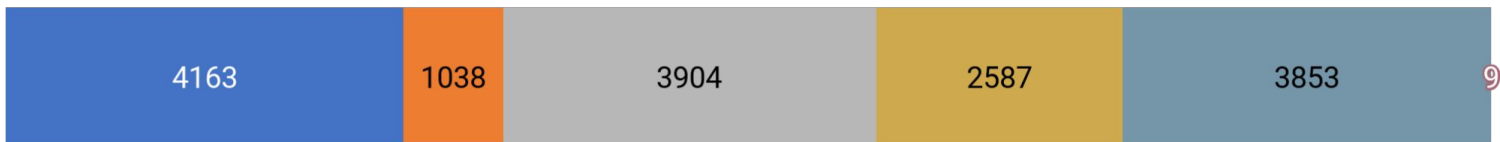
Transfers to Mainland



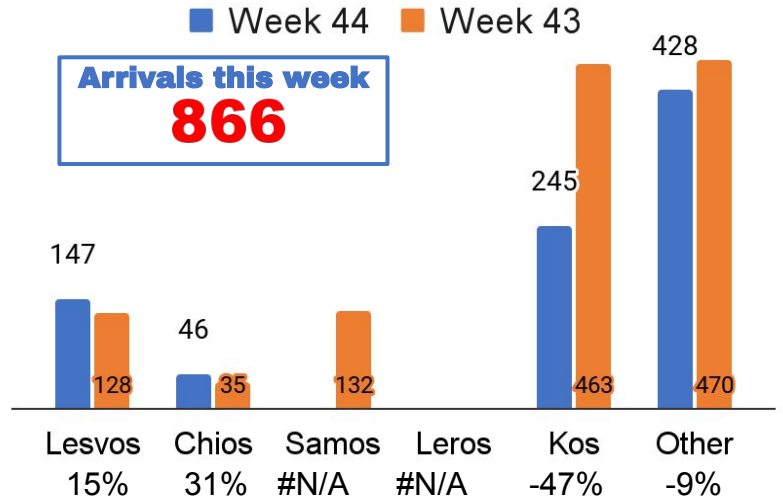
Transfers to mainland have increased 3.6% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.554 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 44 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

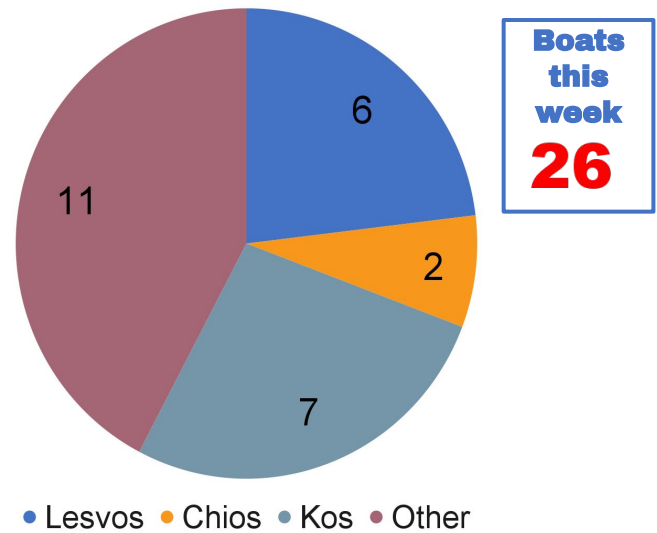


People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 29.5% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 47 boats last week to 26 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 125 boats last week to 88 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 62 boats, 70.5%, 26 boats, 29.5%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.190 boat have arrived on the Islands, 58.7% have been picked up by TCG.
