

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**54** BOATS  
**1438** PEOPLE

A total of 99 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 2.722 people. 54 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.284 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.745 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 50.976 people. 31.987 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.235 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.


### Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have decreased 1.1% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.548 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 309 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




### People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 48.3% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 26 boats last week to 45 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 88 boats last week to 99 boats this week.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 54 boats, 54.5%, 45 boats, 45.5%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.235 boat have arrived on the Islands, 58.6% have been picked up by TCG.
