

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

36 BOATS
1152 PEOPLE

A total of 69 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 2.094 people. 36 boats were stopped/pushback, and 942 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.815 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 53.011 people. 34.102 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.306 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.


Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have decreased 60.7% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.945 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 130 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 19.7% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 38 boats last week to 33 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 72 boats last week to 69 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 36 boats, 52.2%, 33 boats, 47.8%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.306 boat have arrived on the Islands, 58.2% have been picked up by TCG.
