
### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**40** BOATS  
**1301** PEOPLE

A total of 57 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.773 people. 40 boats were stopped/pushback, and 472 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 40 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 1.301 people. 472 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 17 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland


■ Week 1 ■ Week 52



Transfers to mainland have decreased 69% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 16.361 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 294 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea


### Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




### People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have decreased 43.1% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 27 boats last week to 17 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 84 boats last week to 47 boats this week.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 40 boats, 70.2%, 17 boats, 29.8%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 17 boat have arrived on the Islands, 70.2% have been picked up by TCG.
