
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

34 BOATS
937 PEOPLE

A total of 55 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.684 people. 34 boats were stopped/pushback, and 747 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 95 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 2.951 people. 1.800 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 57 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 23.1% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.874 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 494 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea


Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have increased 28.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 19 boats last week to 21 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 40 boats last week to 55 boats this week.

This week TCG/police have picked up 34 boats, 61.8%, 21 boats, 38.2%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 57 boat have arrived on the Islands, 62.5% have been picked up by TCG.
