
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

25 BOATS
773 PEOPLE

A total of 47 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.495 people. 25 boats were stopped/pushback, and 722 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 120 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 3.724 people. 2.522 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 79 boat, so far in 2023. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have decreased 29% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 15.864 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 2 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 3.4% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 21 boats last week to 22 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 55 boats last week to 47 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 25 boats, 53.2%, 22 boats, 46.8%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 79 boat have arrived on the Islands, 60.3% have been picked up by TCG.
