
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

33 BOATS
854 PEOPLE

A total of 49 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.287 people. 33 boats were stopped/pushback, and 433 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 412 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 13.761 people. 7.335 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 219 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland

Transfers to mainland have decreased 7.3% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 10.066 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 2.942 people. Number of people registered on the islands has been reduced due to higher transfer than arrivals, and increase in pusbacks at sea by Greek authorities.


Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have increased 17.3% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 10 boats last week to 16 boats this week. Total number of boats started is identical with last week when 49 boats started towards Greece.

This week TCG/police have picked up 33 boats, 67.4%, 16 boats, 32.6%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 219 boat have arrived on the Islands, 65.3% have been picked up by TCG.
