
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

40 BOATS
1062 PEOPLE

A total of 55 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.498 people. 40 boats were stopped/pushback, and 436 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 340 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 11.784 people. 6.533 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 193 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to mainland have decreased 48.4% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 11.508 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 3.792 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to be temporarily stabilized, due to higher transfer than arrivals and drastically increase in pusbacks at sea


Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have decreased 55.4% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 28 boats last week to 15 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 105 boats last week to 55 boats this week.
