

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

39 BOATS
1175 PEOPLE

A total of 55 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.625 people. 39 boats were stopped/pushback, and 450 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 527 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 15.756 people. 9.262 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 290 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 18.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 9.106 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 830 people. Number of people registered on the islands has been reduced due to higher transfer than arrivals, and increase in pusbacks at sea by Greek authorities.



People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 19.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 24 boats last week to 16 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 46 boats last week to 55 boats this week.

This week TCG/police have picked up 39 boats, 70.9%, 16 boats, 29.1%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 290 boat have arrived on the Islands, 64,5% have been picked up by TCG.
