

Boats Stopped TCG/Police


A total of 68 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.654 people. 44 boats were stopped/pushback, and 676 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 992 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 27.007 people. 16.368 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 547 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

People Arrived on Aegean islands




Arrivals have increased 48.9% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 17 boats last week to 24 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 57 boats last week to 68 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 13.3% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 6.235 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 783 people. Number of people registered on the islands has been reduced due to higher transfer than arrivals, and increase in pusbacks at sea by Greek authorities.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 44 boats, 64.7%, 24 boats, 35.3%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 523 boat have arrived on the Islands, 64,5% have been picked up by TCG.
