Boats Stopped TCG/Police


50 BOATS

A total of 82 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 2.070 people. 50 boats were stopped/pushback, and 781 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.070 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 29.149 people. 18.137 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 610 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.


Arrivals this week

Arrivals have decreased 21% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 31 boats last week to 32 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 59 boats last week to 82 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 17.8% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 5.916 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 1.003 people. Number of people registered on the islands has been reduced due to higher transfer than arrivals, and increase in pusbacks at sea by Greek authorities.

This week TCG/police have picked up 50 boats, 61%, 32 boats, 39%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 610 boat have arrived on the Islands, 63.7% have been picked up by TCG.
