

Boats Stopped TCG/Police


A total of 132 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 3.543 people. 79 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.592 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.383 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 37.064 people. 24.230 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 826 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

People Arrived on Aegean islands




Arrivals have increased 13% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 38 boats last week to 45 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 92 boats last week to 109 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 18.8% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 8.274 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 2.290 people. Number of people registered on the islands is slightly increasing due to low transfers to mainland, people trying to cross is rapidly increasing, pushbacks are reducing arrivals.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 79 boats, 59.9%, 53 boats, 40.1%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 826 boat have arrived on the Islands, 62.6% have been picked up by TCG.
