

Boats Stopped TCG/Police


A total of 89 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 2.748 people. 35 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.782 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.926 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 51.028 people. 37.705 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.299 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

People Arrived on Aegean islands




Arrivals have increased 6.3% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 53 boats last week to 54 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 81 boats last week to 89 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 56.9% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 10.767 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 1.1170 people. Number of people incarcerated on the islands is increasing, due to more people arriving than authorities transfer to the mainland, we expect numbers to continue to increase the coming months.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 35 boats, 39.3%, 54 boats, 60.7%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.299 boat have arrived on the Islands, 59.7% have been picked up by TCG.
