

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

57 BOATS
1611 PEOPLE

A total of 105 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 3.198 people. 57 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.587 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 1.983 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 52.639 people. 39.292 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.347 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.


Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have increased 10% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 11.296 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 1.771 people. Number of people incarcerated on the islands is increasing, due to more people arriving than authorities transfer to the mainland, we expect numbers to continue to increase the coming months.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 10.9% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 54 boats last week to 48 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 89 boats last week to 105 boats this week.

This week TCG/police have picked up 57 boats, 54.3%, 48 boats, 45.7%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.347 boat have arrived on the Islands, 59.5% have been picked up by TCG.
