

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

47 BOATS
1339 PEOPLE

A total of 101 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 3.157 people. 47 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.818 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 2.030 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 53.978 people. 41.110 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.401 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.


Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have increased 96.7% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 12.216 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 3.011 people. Number of people incarcerated on the islands is increasing, due to more people arriving than authorities transfer to the mainland, we expect numbers to continue to increase the coming months.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 14.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 48 boats last week to 54 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 105 boats last week to 101 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 47 boats, 46.5%, 54 boats, 53.5%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 1.401 boat have arrived on the Islands, 59.2% have been picked up by TCG.
