

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

50 BOATS
1349 PEOPLE

A total of 82 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 2.267 people. 50 boats were stopped/pushback, and 1.349 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 2.206 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 58.882 people. 44.835 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 1.516 boat, so far in 2024. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to mainland have decreased 26.7% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 12.352 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 1.061 people. Number of people incarcerated on the islands is increasing, due to more people arriving than authorities transfer to the mainland, we expect numbers to continue to increase the coming months.


Population on the Aegean islands

People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 18.2% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 34 boats last week to 32 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 88 boats last week to 82 boats this week.
