

Boats Stopped TCG/Police


A total of 36 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 921 people. 21 boats were stopped/pushback, and 410 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 94 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 2.898 people. 1.885 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 60 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

People Arrived on Aegean islands




Arrivals have decreased 50.3% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 25 boats last week to 15 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 57 boats last week to 27 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 71.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 12.528 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 643 people. Number of people registered on the islands seem to have been temporarily stabilized. We expect numbers of arrivals to go down in the time to come, due to normal seasonal reduction in arrivals.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 21 boats, 58.3%, 15 boats, 41.7%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 60 boat have arrived on the Islands, 61% have been picked up by TCG.
