
### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**7** BOATS  
**142** PEOPLE

A total of 18 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 448 people. 7 boats were stopped/pushback, and 306 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 141 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 4.253 people. 2.848 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 98 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 12.3% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 10.406 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 2.345 people. Number of people registered on the islands is reducing slightly due to fewer arrivals than transfers. We expect numbers of arrivals to go down in the time to come, due to normal seasonal reduction in arrivals.


### Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




### People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have increased 4.4% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 12 boats last week to 11 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 28 boats last week to 18 boats this week.
