

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

17 BOATS
392 PEOPLE

A total of 27 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 629 people. 17 boats were stopped/pushback, and 237 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 302 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 7.529 people. 6.900 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 236 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland




Transfers this week

Transfers to mainland have increased 59.2% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 7.381 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 1.223 people. Number of people registered on the islands is reducing slightly due to fewer arrivals than transfers. We expect numbers of arrivals to go down in the time to come, due to normal seasonal reduction in arrivals.


Population on the Aegean islands

People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 71.7% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 7 boats last week to 10 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 24 boats last week to 27 boats this week.
