

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**13** BOATS  
**286** PEOPLE

A total of 25 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 577 people. 13 boats were stopped/pushback, and 291 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 425 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 10.559 people. 9.638 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 341 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 67.6% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 6.372 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 343 people. Number of people registered on the islands is again slightly increasing, due to more arrivals than transfers. We expect numbers of arrivals to increase in the time to come, due to normal seasonal change.


### Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




### People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have decreased 44.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 20 boats last week to 12 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 41 boats last week to 25 boats this week.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 13 boats, 52%, 12 boats, 48%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 341 boat have arrived on the Islands, 55.5% have been picked up by TCG.
