

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

23 BOATS
557 PEOPLE

A total of 49 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.308 people. 23 boats were stopped/pushback, and 751 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 518 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 12.707 people. 11.859 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 418 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland




Transfers to mainland have decreased 31% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 6.326 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 46 people. Number of people registered on the islands is again slightly increasing, due to more arrivals than transfers. We expect numbers of arrivals to increase in the time to come, due to normal seasonal change.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other




People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 129% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 11 boats last week to 26 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 37 boats last week to 49 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 23 boats, 46.9%, 26 boats, 53.1%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 418 boat have arrived on the Islands, 55.3% have been picked up by TCG.
