

Boats Stopped TCG/Police


A total of 43 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.153 people. 25 boats were stopped/pushback, and 434 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 594 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 14.570 people. 13.304 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 471 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

People Arrived on Aegean islands




Arrivals have decreased 26.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 19 boats last week to 18 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 40 boats last week to 43 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 67.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 6.245 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 232 people. Number of people registered on the island seems to have been temporarily stabilised. We expect numbers to slowly increase in the time to come, due to normal seasonal changes.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 25 boats, 58.1%, 18 boats, 41.9%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 471 boat have arrived on the Islands, 55.8% have been picked up by TCG.
