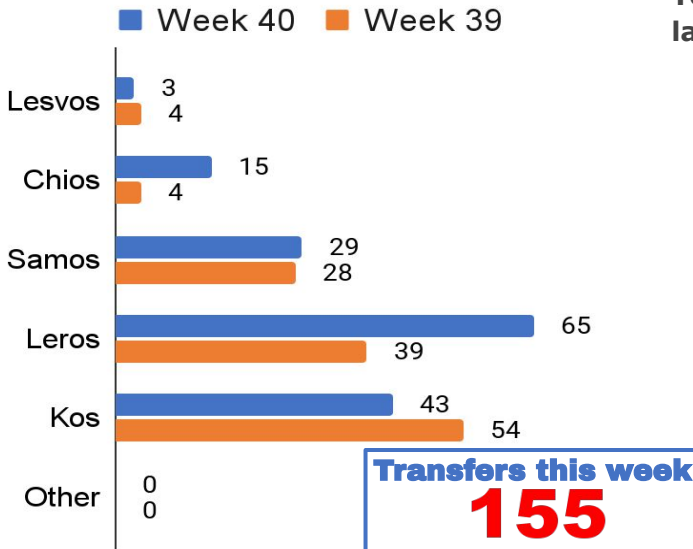

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**29** BOATS  
**741** PEOPLE

A total of 49 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 1.799 people. 29 boats were stopped/pushback, and 634 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 774 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 19.325 people. 16.944 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 582 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

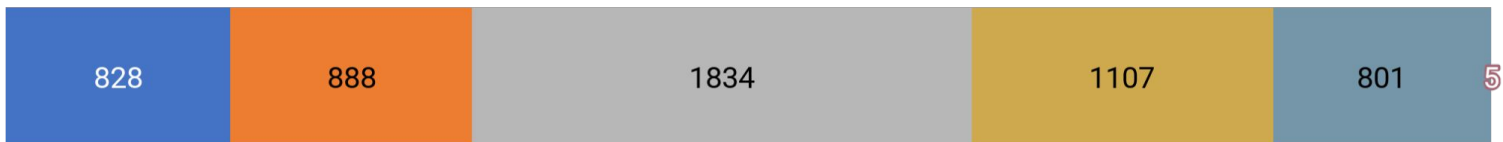
### Transfers to Mainland



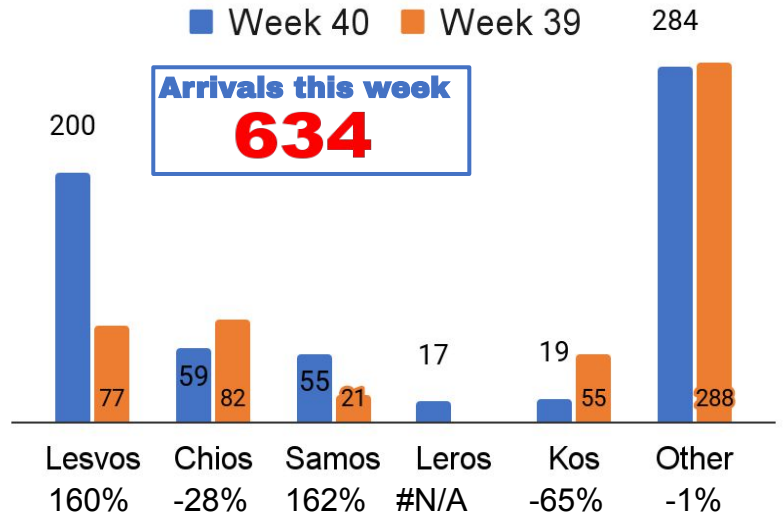
Transfers to mainland have increased 20.2% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 5.463 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 158 people. Number of people registered on the island seems to have been temporarily stabilised. Numbers on the islands have been stabilised, slowly decreasing, due to a combination of transfers to mainland, low arrival numbers and pushbacks.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

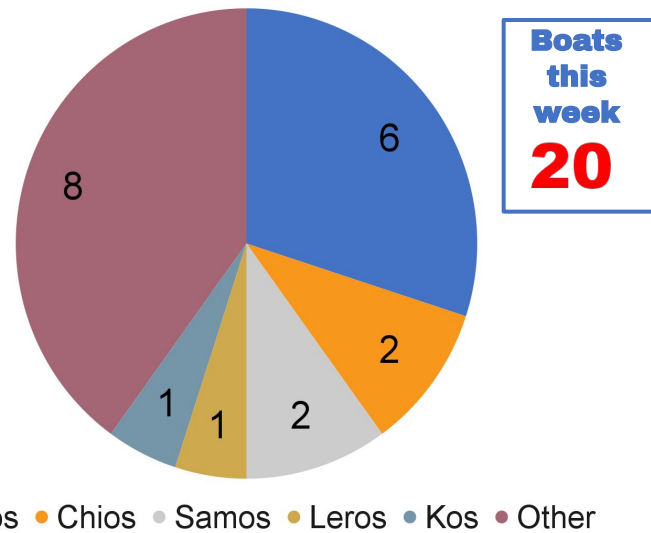


### People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 21.2% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 17 boats last week to 20 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 39 boats last week to 49 boats this week.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 29 boats, 59.2%, 20 boats, 40.8%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 582 boat have arrived on the Islands, 57.1% have been picked up by TCG.
