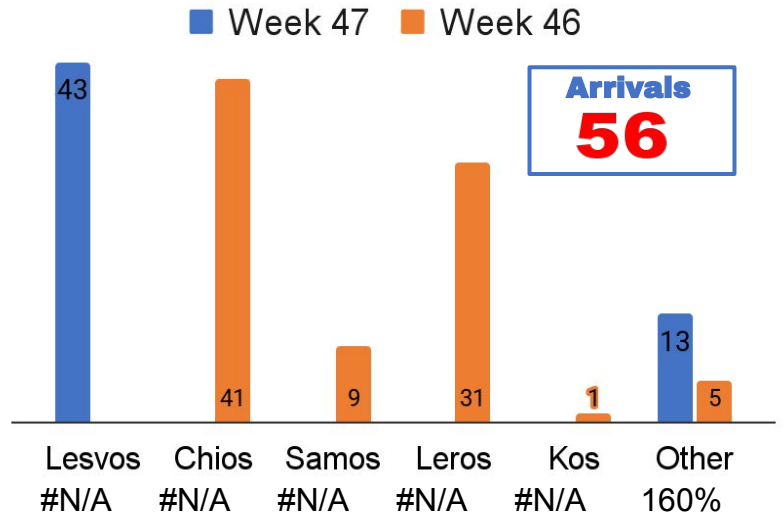

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

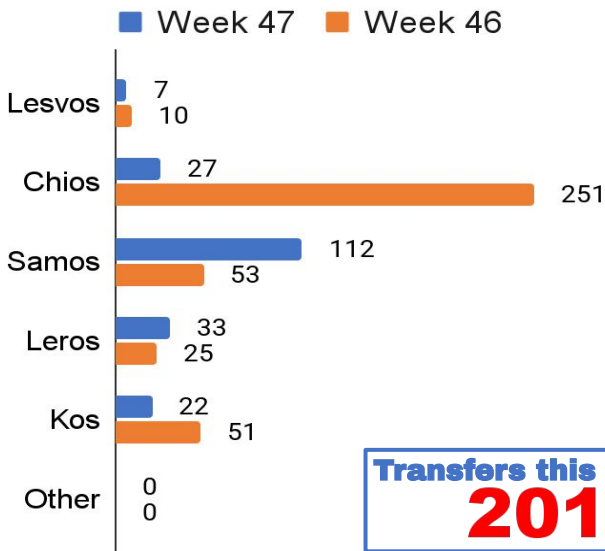
A total of 14 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 371 people. 12 boats were stopped/pushback, and 56 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 927 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 23.385 people. 19.342 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 662 boat, so far in 2025. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

People Arrived on Aegean islands



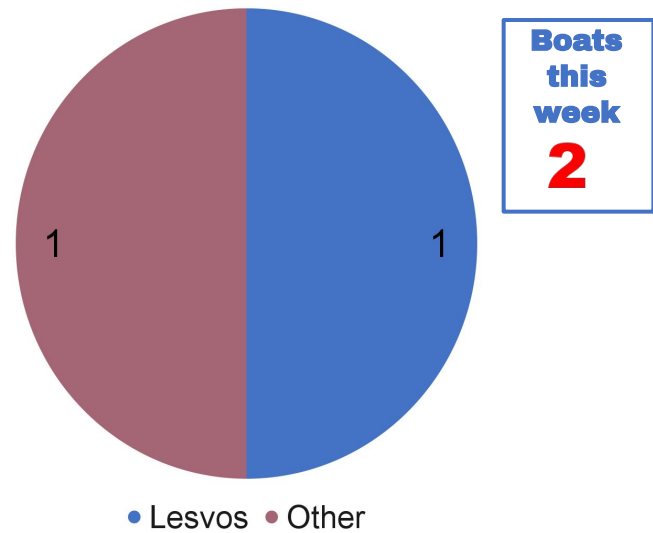
Arrivals have decreased 35.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 4 boats last week to 2 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 27 boats last week to 14 boats this week.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 48.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 5.577 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 228 people. Number of people registered on the island, seems to have been temporarily stabilised. Over the last months we have registered a steep increase of Afghan nationals, large families, who have been crossing towards the Greek Aegean Islands from Turkey.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 12 boats, 85.7%, 2 boats, 14.3%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 662 boat have arrived on the Islands, 58.3% have been picked up by TCG.
