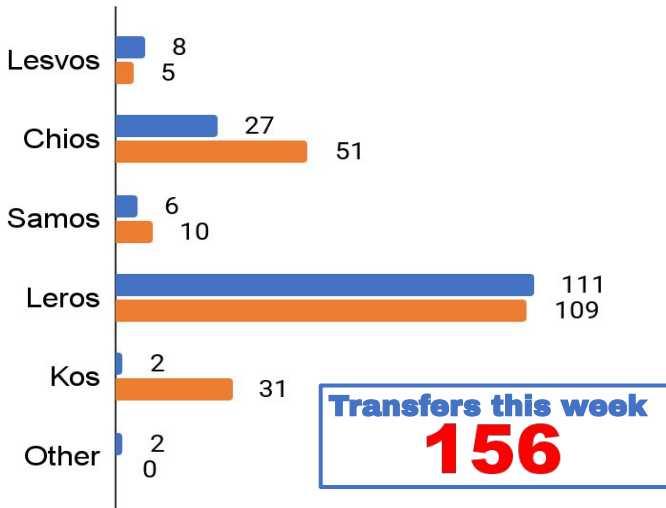
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

11 BOATS
295 PEOPLE

A total of 21 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 612 people. 11 boats were stopped/pushback, and 317 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 11 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 295 people. 317 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 10 boats, so far in 2026. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland

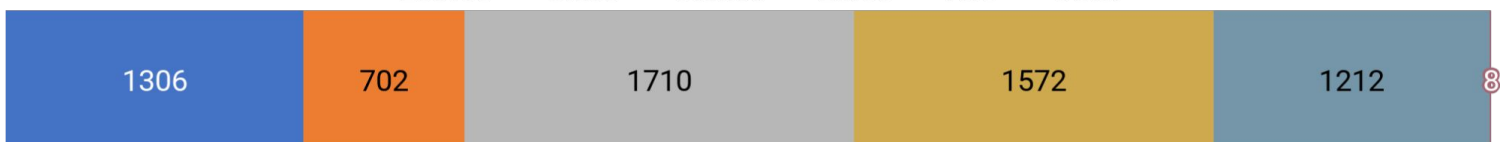

Transfers to mainland have decreased 24.3% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 6.510 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 1.128 people. Number of people registered on the island, seems to have been temporarily stabilised. In the end of December large transfers from Crete to Kos and Leros, due to the increased arrivals on Crete, has drastically increased numbers on these islands.

Population on the Aegean islands

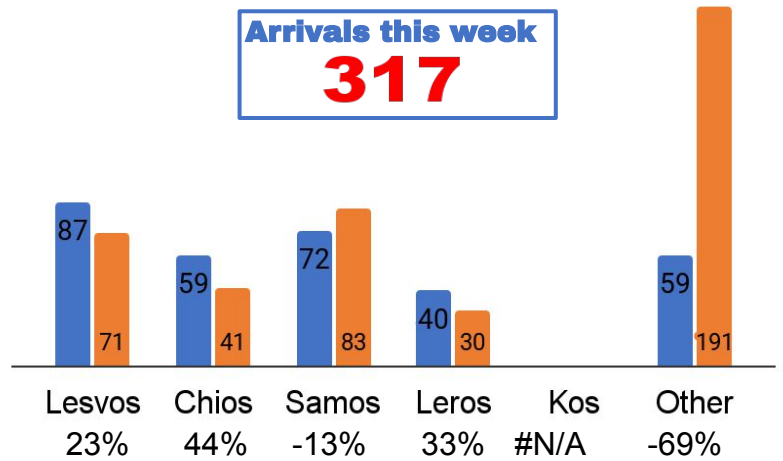

People Arrived on Aegean islands

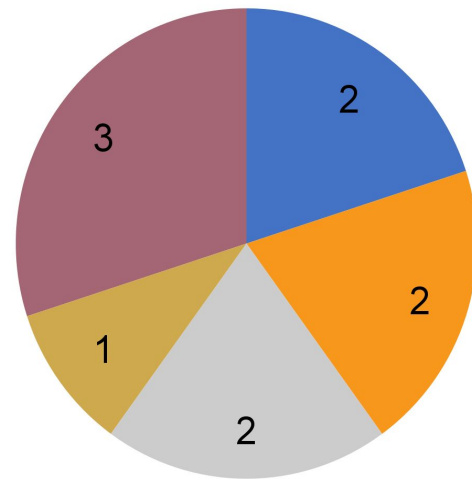
