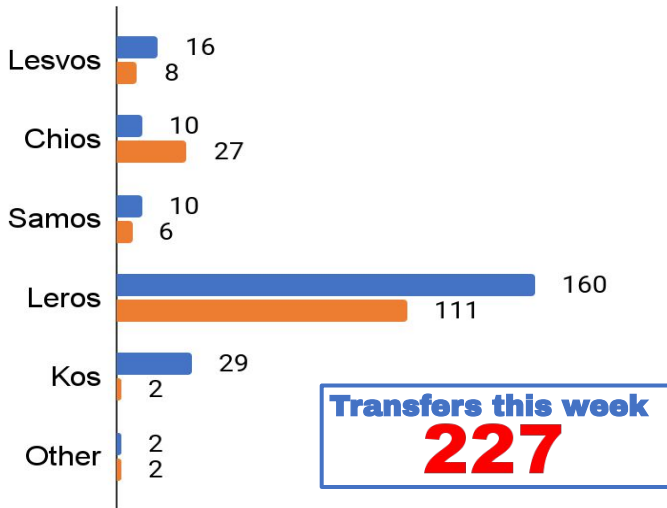
Boats Stopped TCG/Police

5 BOATS
131 PEOPLE

A total of 10 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 297 people. 5 boats were stopped/pushback, and 166 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 16 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 426 people. 483 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 15 boats, so far in 2026. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

Transfers to Mainland

Transfers to mainland have increased 45.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 7.014 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 1.740 people. Number of people registered on the island, seems to have been temporarily stabilised. In the end of December large transfers from Crete to Kos and Leros, due to the increased arrivals on Crete, has drastically increased numbers on these islands.

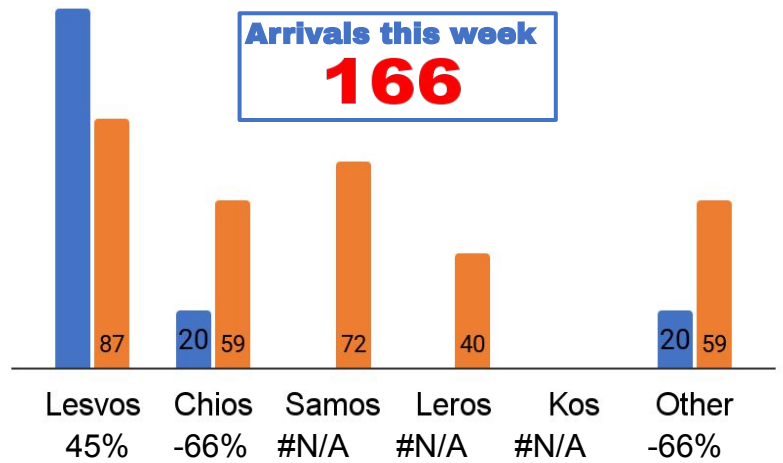
Population on the Aegean islands

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other



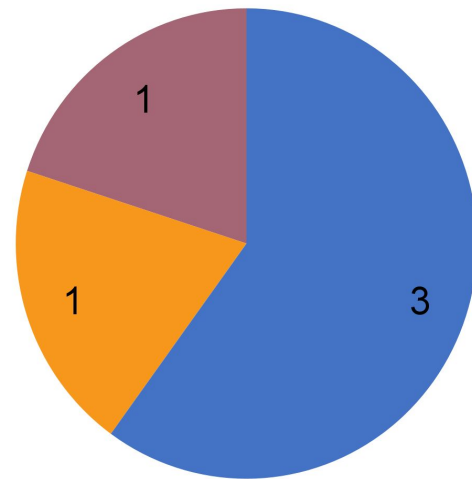
People Arrived on Aegean islands

Arrivals have decreased 47.6% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 10 boats last week to 5 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 21 boats last week to 10 boats this week.

This week TCG/police have picked up 5 boats, 50%, 5 boats, 50%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 15 boat have arrived on the Islands, 51.6% have been picked up by TCG.
