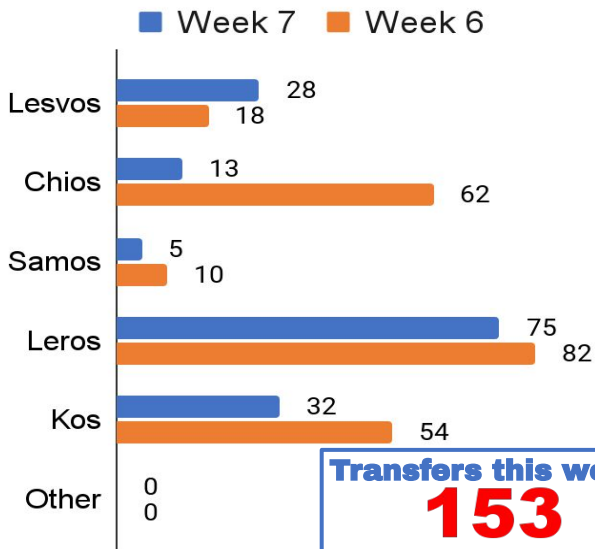

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

10 BOATS
198 PEOPLE

A total of 18 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 425 people. 10 boats were stopped/pushback, and 227 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 66 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 1.601 people. 1.535 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 49 boats, so far in 2026. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

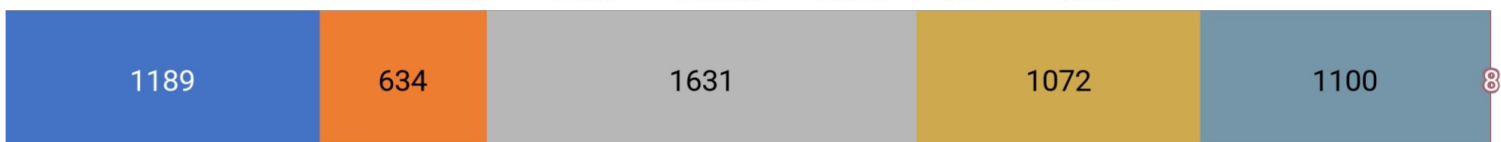
Transfers to Mainland



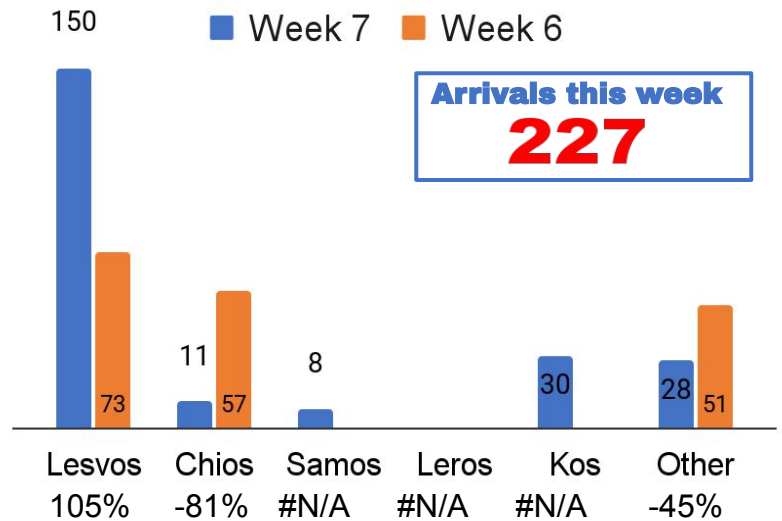
Transfers to mainland have decreased 32.3% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 5.634 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 968 people. Number of people registered on the island, seems to have been temporarily stabilised. In the end of December large transfers from Crete to Kos and Leros, due to the increased arrivals on Crete, has drastically increased numbers on these islands.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

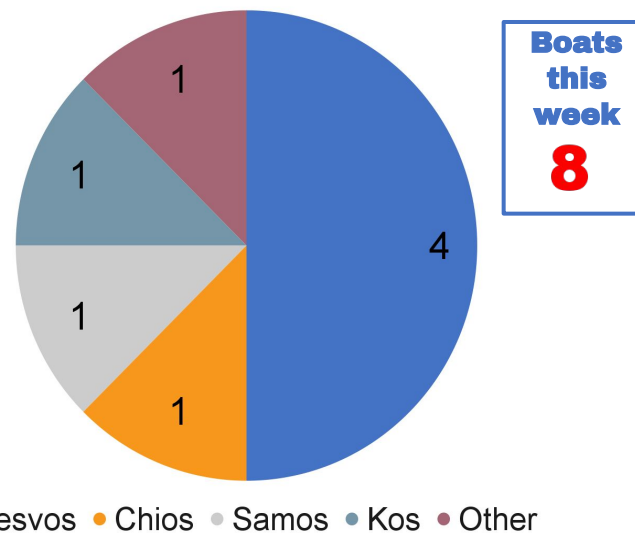


People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 25.4% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 7 boats last week to 8 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 14 boats last week to 18 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 10 boats, 55.6%, 8 boats, 44.4%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 49 boat have arrived on the Islands, 57.4% have been picked up by TCG.
