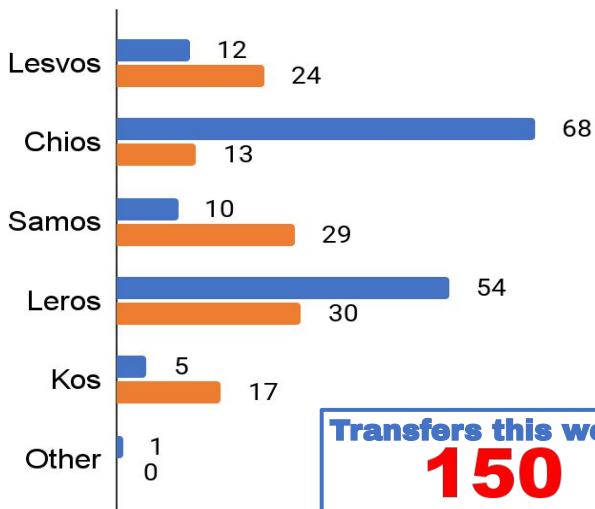
### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**10** BOATS  
**258** PEOPLE

A total of 17 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 513 people. 10 boats were stopped/pushback, and 255 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 87 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 2.132 people. 1.928 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 61 boats, so far in 2026. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

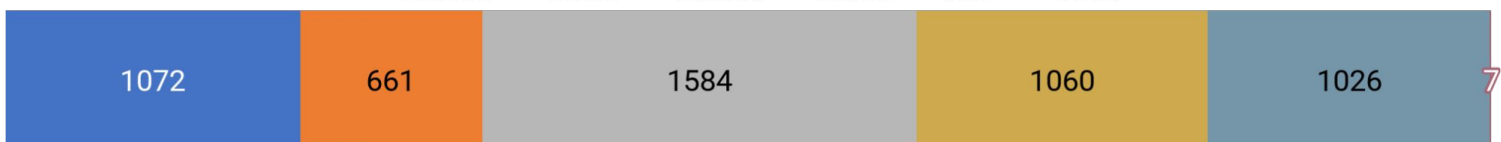


**Transfers this week**

Transfers to mainland have increased 32.7% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 5.410 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 580 people. Number of people registered on the island, seems to have been temporarily stabilised. In the end of December large transfers from Crete to Kos and Leros, due to the increased arrivals on Crete, has drastically increased numbers on these islands.

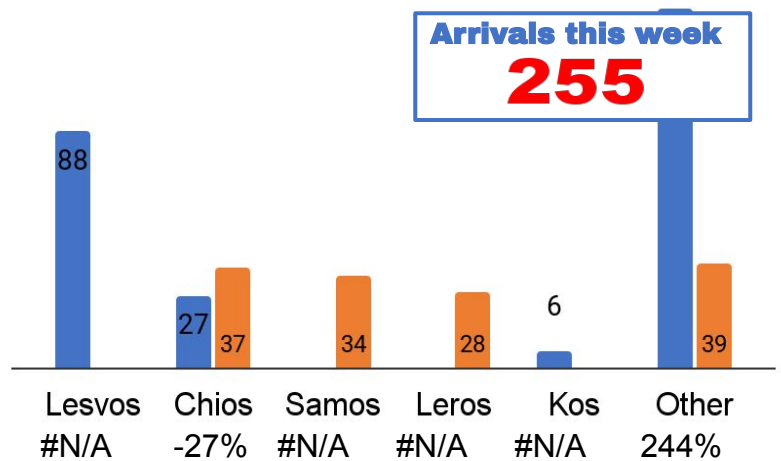
### Population on the Aegean islands

### People Arrived on Aegean islands

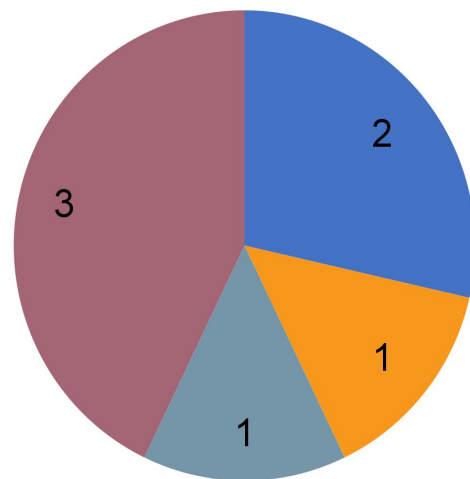

Arrivals have increased 84.8% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 5 boats last week to 7 boats this week. Total number of boats started is up from 16 boats last week to 17 boats this week.
