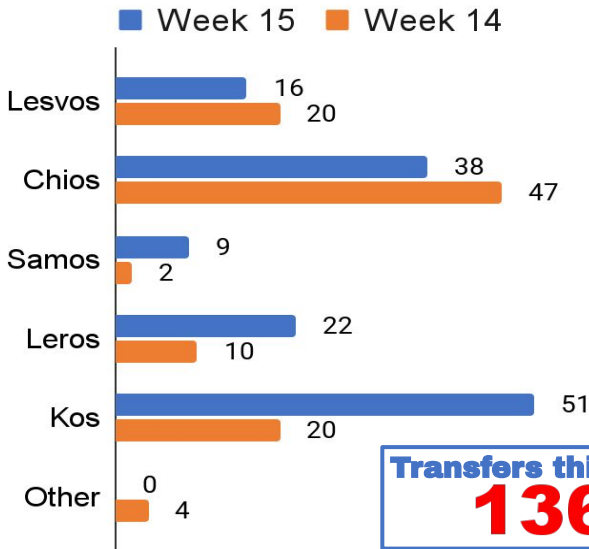

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**6** BOATS  
**102** PEOPLE

A total of 8 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 133 people. 6 boats were stopped/pushback, and 31 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 141 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 3.547 people. 2.386 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 80 boats, so far in 2026. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland

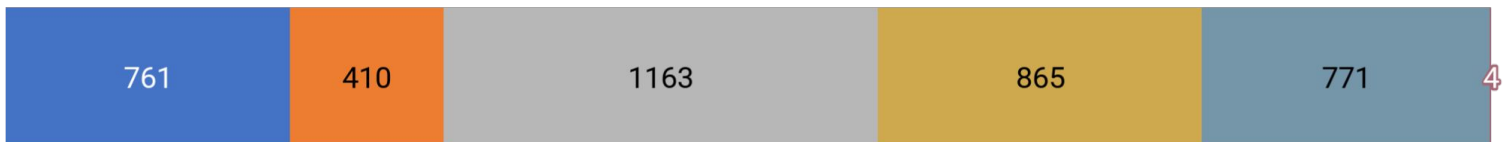

Transfers to mainland have increased 32% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 3.974people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 1.077 people. Number of people registered on the island, seems to have been temporarily stabilised. In the end of December large transfers from Crete to Kos and Leros, due to the increased arrivals on Crete, has drastically increased numbers on these islands.

### Population on the Aegean islands

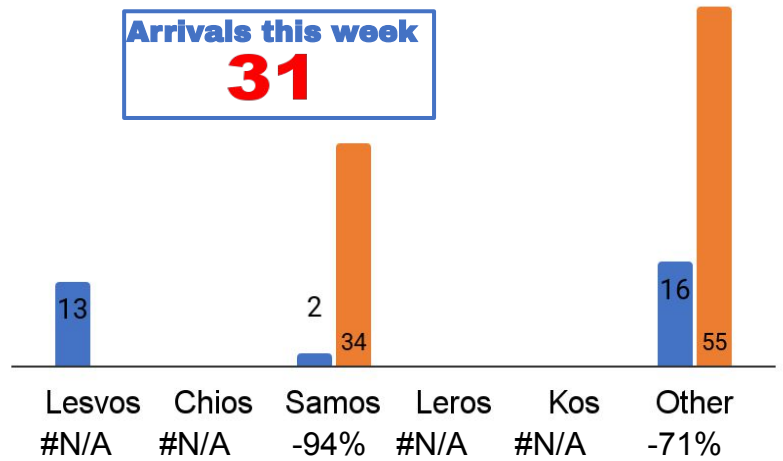

### People Arrived on Aegean islands

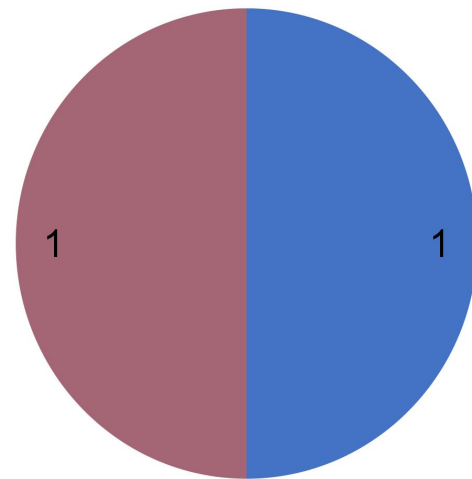

Arrivals have decreased 65.2% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is down from 3 boats last week to 2 boats this week. Total number of boats started is down from 12 boats last week to 8 boats this week.

This week TCG/police have picked up 6 boats, 75%, 2 boats, 25%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 80 boat have arrived on the Islands, 63.8% have been picked up by TCG.
