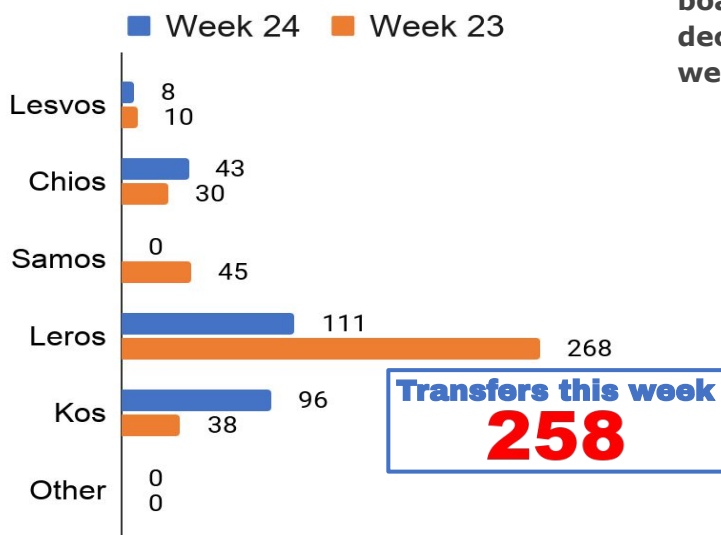

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

9 BOATS
184 PEOPLE

A total of 15 boats started their journey towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying 312 people. Of these, 9 boats were stopped/pushed back, while 128 people were registered on the Greek islands. So far this year, 241 boats carrying 5.653 people have been picked up by the Turkish Coast Guard and police. In the same period, 3.514 people have been registered as arriving on the Greek islands on 126 boats. These numbers should have been significantly higher if not for pushbacks carried out by the Hellenic Coast Guard.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have decreased 34% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 3.985 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 676 people. This increase is largely driven by continued transfers from Crete to the islands.

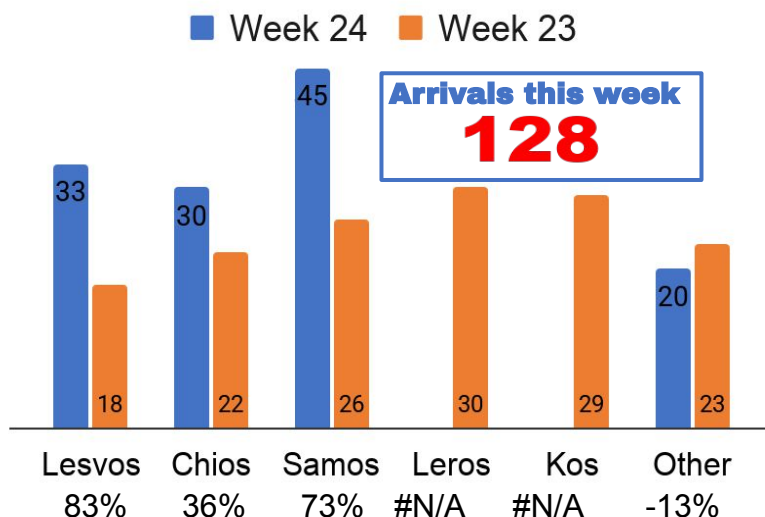
Without sustained relocations, population levels are likely to rise again as arrivals continue. Transfers remain the only effective measure to reduce pressure on the islands.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

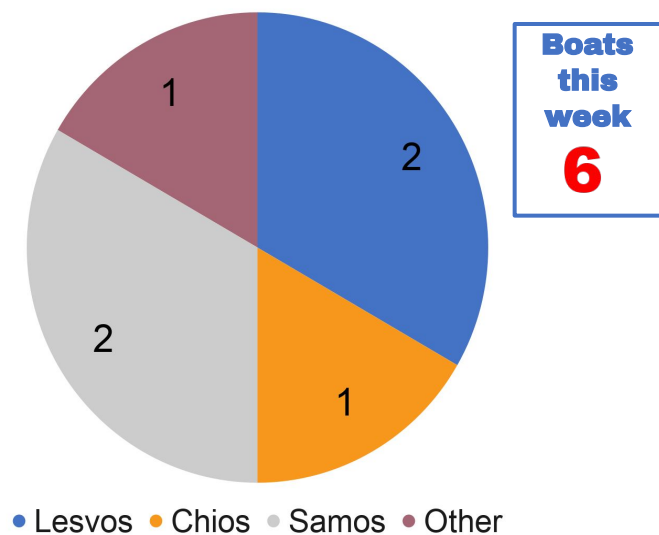


People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have decreased 13.5% compared to last week. The number of registered boats arriving on the islands is identical with last week arrivals, 6 boats. The total number of boats departing has decreased from 21 boats last week to 15 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week, TCG/police picked up 9 boats (60%), while 6 boats (40%) reached the Greek islands. So far this year, 126 boats have arrived, while 65.7% have been intercepted by TCG.
