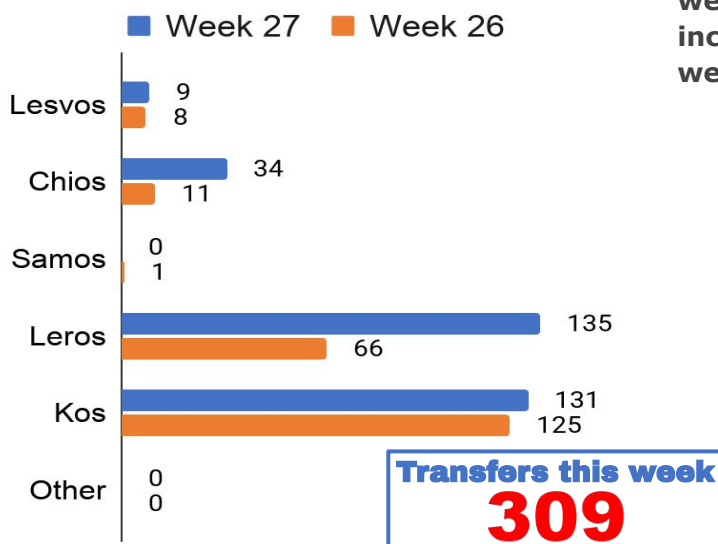

Boats Stopped TCG/Police

12 BOATS
247 PEOPLE

A total of 21 boats started their journey towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying 527 people. Of these, 12 boats were stopped/pushed back, while 280 people were registered on the Greek islands. So far this year, 283 boats carrying 6.503 people have been picked up by the Turkish Coast Guard and police. In the same period, 4.026 people have been registered as arriving on the Greek islands on 144 boats. These numbers should have been significantly higher if not for pushbacks carried out by the Hellenic Coast Guard.

Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 46.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 4.008 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has increased by 666 people. This increase is largely driven by continued transfers from Crete to the islands.

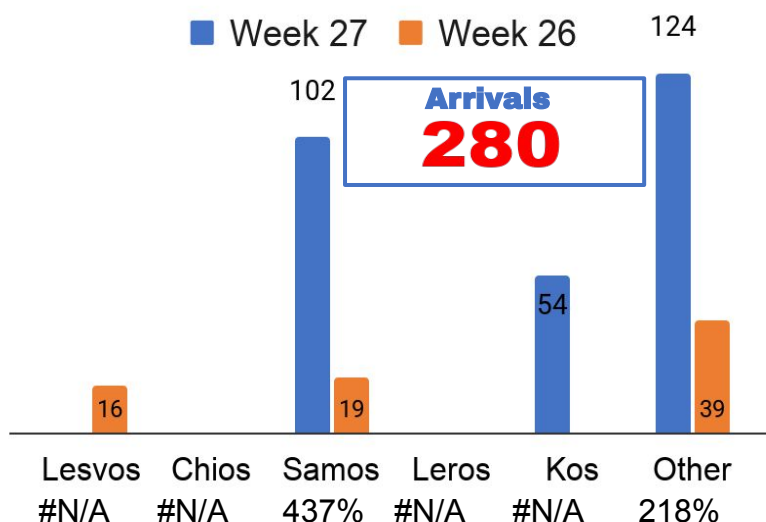
Without sustained relocations, population levels are likely to rise again as arrivals continue. Transfers remain the only effective measure to reduce pressure on the islands.

■ Lesvos ■ Chios ■ Samos ■ Leros ■ Kos ■ Other

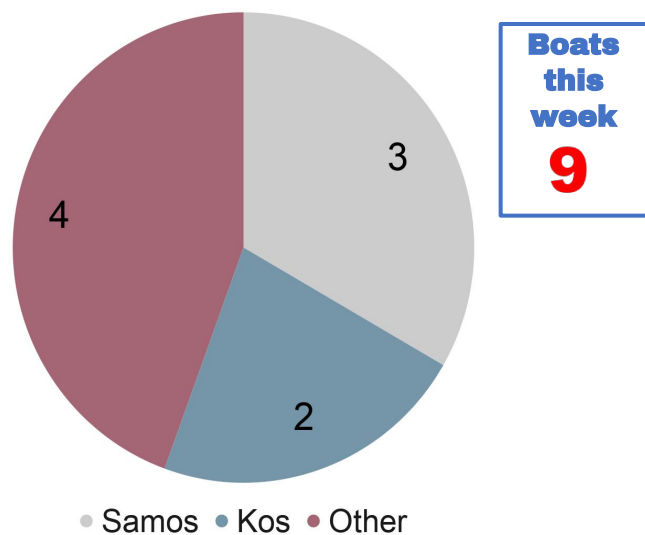


People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 278.4% compared to last week. The number of registered boats arriving on the islands is up from 3 boats last week to 9 this week. The total number of boats departing has increased from 14 boats last week to 21 boats this week.

Boats Arrived on islands



This week, TCG/police picked up 12 boats (57.1%), while 9 boats (42.9%) reached the Greek islands. So far this year, 144 boats have arrived, while 66.3% have been intercepted by TCG.
